Recreation Area Information & Rules 2021

PLEASE READ AND MAKE FAMILY MEMBERS & GUESTS AWARE OF THESE RULES

General

- 1. Exercise common sense and good judgment.
- 2. **PETS ARE NOT** permitted on or in any of the recreation grounds or areas.
- 3. Put trash in trash appropriate trash receptacles. No pet waste allowed in trash or dumpster.
- 4. Bicycles are to be parked in bike rack only.
- 5. Only paid residents and accompanied *quests** are permitted on the recreation grounds.
- 6. **SMOKING/VAPING** not permitted in the pool area or in the clubhouse.
- 7. Unauthorized parking of any vehicle *overnight*** is prohibited.
- 8. Charcoal grill behind clubhouse is for use by clubhouse renters at time of rental only.
- 9. Pavilion will be first come, first serve, and may not be reserved. PLEASE clean & pick up trash.

POOL

- 1. HOUSEHOLDS ARE LIMITED TO 10 INDIVIDUALS TOTAL ON ANY ONE VISIT TO THE POOL. THIS INCLUDES YOUR FAMILY AND YOUR GUESTS. FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE POOL DUE TO LIABILITY ISSUES. IT IS A LAW THAT THE LIFEGUARD/SWIMMER RATIO IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH STATE OF OHIO RULES AND REGULATIONS.
- 2. Residents and their accompanied *guests** may use the pool only if the resident has paid all required Kingsbury dues.
- 3. Pool wristbands will only be issued to those who have paid their dues. Dues may not be paid at the pool.
- 4. Pool wristbands will be delivered within a week of pool opening, if dues are paid on time. Pool wristbands must be worn at all times. Children under the age of two do not have to wear wristbands.
- 5. All people entering the pool must have one member sign in. Failure to sign in creates an impossible situation for the lifeguards to limit pool access to Kingsbury members.
- 6. A paid resident must accompany guests and remain at the pool with their guests at all times.
- 7. Guests must wear guest wristbands. Anyone who is not a Kingsbury resident and is wearing a member's wristband may have the wristband confiscated for the remainder of the season.
- 8. Each paid resident will receive 15 guest wristbands per year, with more given upon request.
- 9. No children under 12 years of age will be allowed at the pool without accompanying adult at least 18 years old.
- 10. No swimming is allowed unless a lifeguard is on duty.
- 11. Swimming attire should be worn in good taste. Cut-offs or other non-bathing suit apparel should not be worn.
- 12. Wading pool use is limited to children under <u>5 years (or non-swimmers) at all times, and children must be with an accompanying adult at least 18 years old.</u>
- 13. The gate to the wading pool must remain closed and children must be supervised at all times.
- 14. Lifeguards will call regularly scheduled breaks. Everyone must exit the pool quickly and remain out of the water until the break is over. If two lifeguards are on duty, ADULTS ONLY may swim during breaks.
- 15. Dangerous objects (metal, glass, pointed throw toys, etc.) are not permitted in the pool area.
- 16. NO DIVING is permitted in the pool due to pool depth.
- * An accompanied guest **IS** a guest of a paid Kingsbury member.
- Overnight parking is limited to 72 hours for emergency use by a guest or member. Any vehicle left over 72 hours will be towed at the owner's expense. Exceptions **ONLY** with approval from Kingsbury Recreation Board.

- 17. The use of flotation devices and pool toys may be used at the discretion of the lifeguards. Lifeguards are in charge of pool behavior, please adhere all requests by any lifeguard.
- 18. Running, dunking, throwing objects, and other horseplay that could jeopardize the safety of others will not be permitted.
- 19. Rough play, "chicken" fights; tossing or lifting of another person will not be permitted.
- 20. Loitering in the restroom is not permitted.
- 21. Vandals will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law. Residents are held responsible for their guests.
- 22. The pool staff, HOA and KRA are **NOT RESPONSIBLE** for items lost or stolen.
- 23. Food is permitted in the pool area and pavilion, but not in the pool or at poolside.
- 24. Please dispose of all trash properly before it blows away and clean up in the pavilion.
- 25. ALCOHOL is **NOt** permitted on pool grounds.
- 26. Clubhouse rental **DOES NOT** include the use of pool or tennis courts.
- 27. For safety reasons, the lifeguard's decision on rules infractions stand.
- 28. Pool tags may be revoked per the Board of Directors for any infractions, including Board members, property manager, or police being called.

The pool will be open from Memorial Day weekend, Saturday May 29, through Labor Day Monday September 6. Hours of operation are as follows:

Non-School Days: 11:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.

School Days August 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. School days are weekdays Aug. 18- Sept.3

Days and times are subject to change, and for weather.

Tennis Courts

- 1. Residents and their accompanied *guests** may use the tennis courts only if the resident has paid all Kingsbury dues.
- 2. Tennis shoes are the only footwear permitted on the tennis courts.
- 3. The tennis courts are for tennis only. Bicycling, rollerblading, and/or skateboarding are not permitted on the courts and may be subject to a fine. NO DOGS OR PETS ALLOWED

Playground

- 1. Residents and their accompanied *guests** may use the playground only if the resident has paid all Kingsbury dues.
- 2. The playground is limited to children ages 2-12. Individuals over 12 are not permitted on the equipment due to weight restrictions.
- 3. Children should be supervised at all times & NO PETS are permitted on recreation grounds.
- 4. Keep the mulch inside the playground area and off the playground equipment.

FOLLOWING THESE GUIDELINES WILL ENSURE KINGSBURY RESIDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS HAVE A **SAFE** AND **CLEAN** RECREATION AREA

- * An accompanied guest **IS** a guest of a paid Kingsbury member.
- Overnight parking is limited to 72 hours for emergency use by a guest or member. Any vehicle left over 72 hours will be towed at the owner's expense. Exceptions **ONLY** with approval from Kingsbury Recreation Board.
